



PFAS in Well Water

Public Information Session

- If you are a resident of New Hanover, Brunswick, Pender or Columbus County
AND
- You use a private well as your primary source of drinking water
AND
- The private well is within ¼ mile of the Cape Fear River
 - OR within 1/4 mile of a PFAS contaminated site/well
 - OR within 1/4 mile of a water or sewer line

You should have your well tested for PFAS. Call Chemours at 910-678-1100 to see if you qualify for a FREE test.

IMPORTANT: Leave a message with your name, address and telephone number to see if you qualify for testing. If you don't currently qualify for well testing, you may in the future. Chemours is required to keep your contact information and notify you if testing expands to your area.
